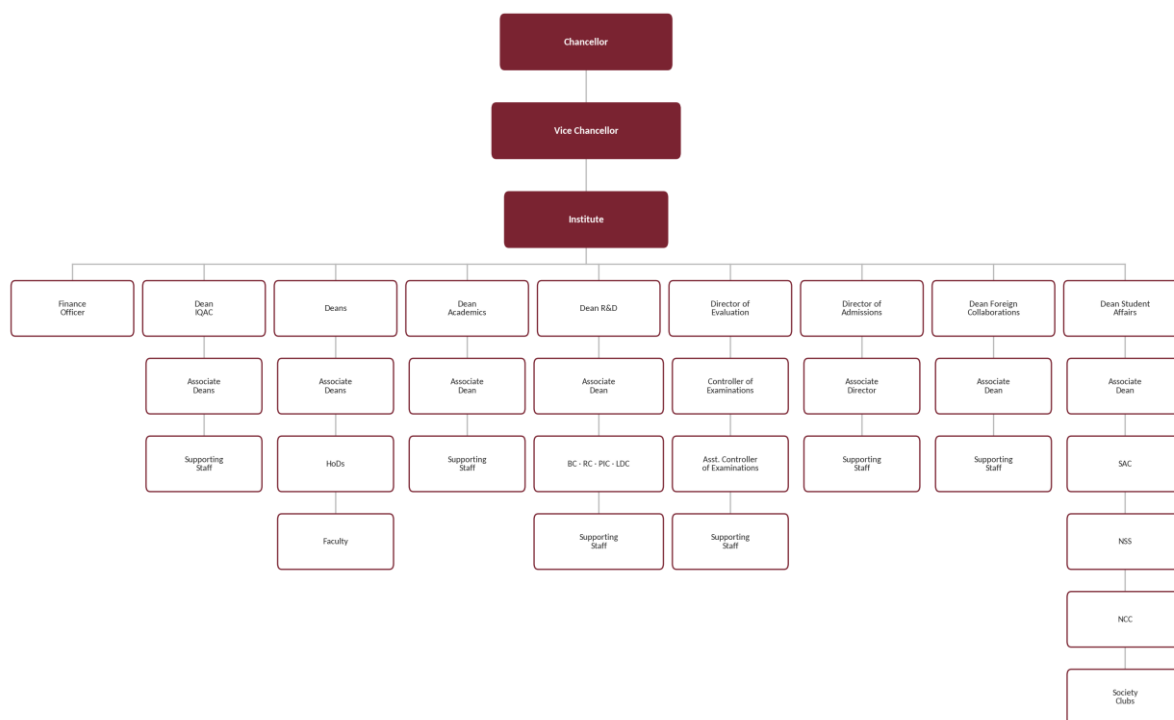

- Strengthen student satisfaction, trust, and participation in institutional decision-making.
- Implement the principles of natural justice and confidentiality in grievance handling.
- Integrate an Online Grievance Redressal System connecting MRDU's internal portal with the UGC SAMADHAAN platform for national-level compliance.

Scope

The cell deals with written grievances from students and faculty on:

- Academic matters — duplicate mark-sheets, transfer certificates, conduct certificates and other examination-related matters.
- Financial matters — dues and payments for library, hostels and other items.
- Other matters — sanitation, food, transport, and victimisation by teachers.

Functions

- Cases are attended to promptly on receipt of a written grievance.
- The cell formally reviews all cases and acts as per Management policy.
- The cell reports to the authority on cases attended to and pending cases requiring further direction.

Procedure for Lodging a Complaint

- Students / faculty may write to grievances@mrdu.edu.in or use the drop-boxes in the admin department.
- The Grievance Cell acts on cases forwarded along with the necessary supporting documents.
- The Grievance Cell ensures the grievance is resolved within the stipulated time limit.
